CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, D. McCuiston has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Shell Creek through pipeline and ditch for irrigation and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 31, T. 37 N., R. 70 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point which bears S. 30° 15' E. 604 feet from NW Corner Section 31, T. 37 N., R. 70 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation: 0.378 c.f.s. or 92 acre feet for the season.
Period of use, from April 1 to July 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: May 5, 1927

36.92 acres in NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 14, T. 37 N., R. 69 E., M.D.B. & M.
1.75 acres in SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 14, T. 37 N., R. 69 E., M.D.B. & M.
37.77 acres--Total.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
