CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER


WHEREAS, Joe Bird has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Natural Channel through ditch for Irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 24, T. 10 N., R. 43 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point which bears S. 18° 25' E. 28.711 feet from N 1/2 Corner Section 27, T. 11 N., R. 43 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913, has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Joe Bird
Post-office address Tonopah, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.12 c.f.s. or 15 acre feet for the season.
Period of use, from March 1st to May 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation February 6, 1925.

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:
12 acres in SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 33, T. 11 N., R. 43 E., M.D.B. & M.
12 acres total.



The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
