**THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER**

WHEREAS, Flora Dean Hobart has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Willow Creek Spring through pipeline and trough for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: approximately NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 35, T. 27 N., R. 48 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point which bears N. 73° 15' W. 5896 feet from NE Cor. T. 26 N., R. 48 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Lureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Flora Dean Hobart
Post-office address: Beowawe, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.05 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 1500 cattle and 200 horses.
Period of use, from: March 15th to December 15th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: September 4, 1925.

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-
Water is conveyed from spring through 25 feet of 2-inch pipe into metal trough 6 feet x 18 inches x 14 inches. Works located approximately NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 35, T. 27 N., R. 48 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
