CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Donnelly Land & Livestock Co., has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Buck Spring

through pipeline and troughs for

stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 23, T. 37 N; R. 24 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point that bears N. 80° 45' W., 6,880 feet from the S.E. Cor. Sec. 24, same township and range.

situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Donnelly Land and Livestock Co.

Post-office address Reno, Washoe County, Nevada.

Amount of appropriation 0.03 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 5,000 sheep.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation June 23, 1928

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is conveyed by means of 30 feet of 1 1/2" pipe to 15 watering troughs each 14 feet long. Works located in SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 23, T. 37 N; R. 24 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
