

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William Gansberg has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Gansberg Spring through pipe line for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 16, T. 12 N, R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M. situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Gardnerville, Douglas County, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 1.57 c.f.s. or 571.98 acre feet per season.
Period of use, from April 15 to October 15 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation December 7, 1925.

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:-

- 40 acres in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 14, T. 12 N; R. 19 E.
40 " " " NW 1/4 NW 1/4 " " " " " "
40 " " " SE 1/4 NW 1/4 " " " " " "
37 " " " SW 1/4 NW 1/4 " " " " " "
157 acres total.

Note: The land to which the water is appurtenant under this certificate is also irrigated under claim of vested right from Sheridan and Stattler Canyon Creeks. The right to the use of water under this certificate is therefore limited to that amount required to satisfy any deficiency in the supply of two above named creeks to which the applicant is entitled under vested right, and in no event shall it exceed the amount herein designated. The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
