CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, E. A. Settelmeyer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Unnamed Spring through pipeline for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 2, T. 23 N; R. 19 E., or at a point that bears S. 48° 40' W., 403 feet from the SW Corner Section 55, T. 24 N; R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: E. A. Settelmeyer
Post-office address: 204 South Center Street, Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0219 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 3500 sheep.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: August 23, 1926.

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-
The water is collected in a 6' x 4' reservoir located 100 feet below the spring. 100 feet of 1-inch galvanized pipe conveys the water from the reservoir to two galvanized iron troughs. Works located in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 2, T. 23 N; R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
