WHEREAS, Fernando Segura has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from _____ Number Four Spring _____

through _____ dams _____ for _____ stock watering _____

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 3, T. 15 N; R. 51 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point which bears N. 6° 55' W., 393.26 from the East quarter of said Section 3.

situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 172, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator. Fernando Segura
Post-office address. Eureka, Nevada
Amount of appropriation. 0.006 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 1000 head of sheep.
Period of use, from July 1st to December 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation. August 25, 1916.

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-
The spring channel has been cleaned from the point of diversion to seven earth dams 4 feet to 7 feet long and 1 foot to 2 feet high creating small reservoirs. Works located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 2 and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 3, T. 15 N; R. 51 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
