CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, George H. Sharp has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Blind Spring

through pipe line and trough for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Approximately in the SE 1/4 Section 12, T. 7 N; R. 36 E., M.D.B. & M. unsurveyed, situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: George H. Sharp
Post-office address: Curren, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0039 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 125 cattle
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: January 5, 1928

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: A well 5 ft. in diameter, and 4 ft. deep, has been dug at the spring. The water is piped from the bottom of the well by means of 10 feet of 1" pipe to a trough 10 feet long, 12 inches wide, and 18 inches deep, and located in the same subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
