CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Isaac M. Springer, Jr. has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Hot Spring through pipe line for Domestic and service station

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 12, T. 22 N., R. 26 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point that bears S. 80° 23' E., 2,433 ft. from the W. 1/4 Corner of said Section 12.

situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation January 29, 1927.

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

The water from the spring is conveyed N. 66° 05' W., by means of 477 ft. of 3" W. I. pipe, 657 ft. of 2 1/2" W. I. pipe and 518 ft. of 2" W. I. pipe, to a storage tank 8 ft. in diameter, 8 ft. deep and 30 ft. above the ground; thence by means of a system of pipe lines the water is conveyed to Auto Camp Cabins, Cottages and a concrete swimming pool 81 ft. long, 44 ft. wide and 3 to 9 ft. deep. The place of use is in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 12, T. 22 N; R. 26 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified; and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
