

# THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Bertrand Paris, by H. M. Payne has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Rye Grass Well through pipeline and troughs for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 7, Section 7, T. 22 N., R. 61 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point that bears S. 1° 51' E., 60,160 feet from the SE Corner section 12, T. 24 N., R. 60 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Bertrand Paris  
Post-office address Cherry Creek, Nevada  
Amount of appropriation 0.0375 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 2000 sheep  
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation October 1, 1929

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Dug well about 5 feet square and sixty feet deep, timbered 10 feet up from the bottom and 20 feet down from the top. About 20 feet of water in well. Gas engine and pump installed and water is conveyed through about 10 feet of 2 1/2 inch pipe to approximately ninety feet of semi-circular galvanized iron troughs, 22 inches wide and 12 inches deep.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
