CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, E. D. Farnham has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Hot Springs

through ditch and reservoir for

stockwatering and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 4, T. 44 N.; R. 31 E., N.D.B. 1. or at a point that bears S. 41° 08' W., 1555 feet from the NE Corner of the said section 4.

situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator E. D. Farnham

Post-office address Winnemucca, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.05 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 5000 sheep and 700 cattle.

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation January 14, 1930

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-

A bulkhead at the point of diversion diverts the water into a ditch 800 feet long, 4 feet wide, and 1 foot deep. The ditch conveys the water to a small reservoir formed by an earth dam 24 feet long and 2 1/2 feet high. The reservoir is located in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 4, T. 44 N.; R. 31 E., N.D.B. 1.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which

acquired.
