CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, T. D. Farnham has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Middle Fork Big Creek through dam and reservoir for stockwatering and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 20, T. 44 N., R. 30 E., M. D. B. & M., or at a point that bears S. 81° 02' E., 233 feet from the W 1/2 corner of the said Section 20. situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: T. D. Farnham
Post-office address: Winnemucca, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.06 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 6000 sheep and 700 cattle.
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: January 14, 1930

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: A rock dam, about 25 feet long and 5 feet high, constructed across the channel of the creek, forming a small reservoir which is located in the same legal subdivision as the point of diversion.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
