CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Central Pacific Railway Co., by / has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Star Canyon Creek

through Star Creek pipe line for

General railroad and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 24, T. 31 N; R. 34 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point that bears S. 66° 43' W., 2808 feet from the NE Section Corner of the said Section 24.

situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Central Pacific Railway Company

Post-office address 65 Market Street, San Francisco, California

Amount of appropriation 1.00 c.f.s.

Period of use, from October 15th to March 15th following year of each year

Date of priority of appropriation August 10, 1929.

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-

Works consist of concrete dam under the five feet in height, located at intake of pipe line. The water is conveyed by means of 17,827 feet of 8-inch cast iron pipe and 39,300 feet of 6-inch cast iron pipe, to a 350,000 gallon steel tank at Imlay, Nevada, located in the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 4, T. 32 N; R. 34 E., M.D.B. & M. The pipe line is equipped with pressure valves that regulate the flow of water entering the pipe line of the intake so as not to exceed amount used. Ruling H. C. 21.0 with 6 inch pipe. From the steel tank the water is distributed by a system of pipe lines to locomotive water columns, fire hydrants, railroad shops, other railroad facilities and dwellings.

Note: It is intended by this certificate to grant a right to the use of one c.f.s. of water during a period of the year that may not be covered by any vested rights for irrigation purposes, so that by coordinating the use herein with that granted by Certificate No. 1832, the right becomes continuous throughout the entire year.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
