CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Emil Baumann has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Isaac or Willow Spring through Pipeline for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 1, Sec. 31, T. 25 N., R. 49 E., M. D. B. & M. or at a point that bears S. 21°-45' E, 1074 feet from the NW Cor. of said Sec. 31.

situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Emil Baumann
Post-office address: Cortez, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.022 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 3500 sheep.
Period of use, from Jan. 1 to Dec. 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: Jan. 15, 1930.

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: A reservoir 60 feet long, 25 feet wide and 8 feet deep, constructed at the spring. Sixty feet of 2" iron pipe conveys the water from the reservoir to three metal troughs and one wooden trough. Works located in Lot 1, Sec. 31, T. 25 N., R. 49 E., M. D. B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
