through Reservoir and pipeline for

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 Sec. 26, T. 25 N., R. 54 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point that bears N. 13°-42' W., 1180 feet from the SE. Cor. of said Sec. 26.

situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of

1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator O. R. Mau

Post-office address Eureka, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.025 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 4000 sheep.

Period of use, from April 1 to Nov. 1 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation August 10, 1927.

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-

A reservoir, 20 feet square and 5 feet deep constructed at the spring, from which 20 feet of 2 inch pipe conveys the water to two galvanized troughs, each 1 foot deep and 10 feet long. Works located in the SE 1/4 Sec. 26, T. 25 N., R. 54 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified; and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
