CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS George N. Fish has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from East Walker River through Ross Ditch for Irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 15, T. 11 N., R. 26 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point that bears S. 24°-00' E., 3980 feet from the 1/4 Cor. common to Sec. 9 & 10 T. 11 N., R. 26 E., M.D.B.&M. situated in Lyon County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE. That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: George N. Fish
Post-office address: 2604- 12th Ave., Oakland, California
Amount of appropriation: 0.634 c.f.s. or 251 acre feet per season.
Period of use, from: Mar. 15 to Sept. 30 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: March 12, 1918.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
