CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Fred M. Fulstone has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Unnamed Spring through Pipeline for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 31, T. 14 N., R. 24 E., M. D. B. & M. or at a point that bears S. 64°-38' E., 2153 feet from the West 1/4 Cor. of said Sec. 31, situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator F.M. Fulstone, Incorporated
Post-office address Smith, Lyon County, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.025 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 4000 sheep
Period of use, from Sept. 1 to June 1 of each year following year.
Date of priority of appropriation August 29, 1928.

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:-
A sump or reservoir 20 feet long, 16 feet wide and 8 feet deep constructed at the spring, from which the water is conveyed by means of a 1 1/2 inch pipe to 160 feet of concrete troughs 18 inches wide and 10 inches deep. Place of use located in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 31, T. 14 N., R. 24 E., M. D. B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
