

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Bessie Rosevear has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Mount Ophir Spring through Pipeline for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 34, T. 16 N., R. 57 E., M. D. B. & M., or at a point that bears N. 64°-16' E., 2780 feet from the SW. Cor. of said Sec. 34, situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Bessie Rosevear (now Mrs. J. S. Shannon)
Post-office address Duckwater, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0015 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 50 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation October 6, 1922.

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-
Spring developed by means of a cut in earth and water is conveyed in a southerly direction by means of a 1 1/2 inch pipeline to 60 feet of 18 inch half round galvanized iron troughs. Place of use is in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 3, T. 15 N., R. 57 E., M. D. B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
