

# THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Thomas R. Weber has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Weber Spring through Pipeline for Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW1/4 NW1/4 Section 18, T.33 N., R.50 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point that bears S.63°-15'E., 1277 feet from the NW. Corner of said Section 18. situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

 Amount of appropriation 0.025 c.f.s.  
 Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year  
 Date of priority of appropriation June 26, 1916.


Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-  
Spring developed by an excavation in the channel of Mack's Creek.  
The water is collected by means of a concrete cistern, 7 feet X 6 feet, constructed at the spring. A 1 inch pipeline 3000 feet long conveys the water to the SW1/4 SE1/4 Section 12, T.33 N., R.49 E., M.D.B.&M. where it is used for domestic purposes and the irrigation of a small garden.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
