

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, F. C. Hummel has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Big Cedar Creek through Big Cedar Creek Ditch for Irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 Sec. 4, T. 38 N., R. 31 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator F. C. Hummel and Pearl Hummel
Post-office address Jungo, Humboldt County, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.70 c.f.s. or 169.09 acre feet for the season.
Period of use, from March 1 to July 1 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation February 16, 1924.

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:-

- 40 acre in the NW 1/4 Sec. 20, T. 38 N., R. 32 E., M.D.B. & M.
30 " " " NW 1/4 Sec. 21, " " " " " " " " " "
70 acres total.

Explanatory note:- Water diverted from Big Cedar Creek through approximately 3/4 mile of ditch to ravine; thence conveyed by said ravine for a distance of approximately 2 miles; thence again diverted and conveyed through approximately 2 3/4 miles of ditch to lands irrigated.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
