CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mrs. Daniela Larios has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Corral Creek through Larios Ditch No. 2 for Irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 Sec. 6, T. 46 N., R. 58 E., M.D.B. & M.; or at a point that bears S. 29°-15' W., 5900 feet from the SE. Cor. Sec. 31, T. 47 N., R. 58 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 2.99 c.f.s. or 914 acre feet per season
Period of use, from April 15 to September 15 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation Feb. 5, 1921.

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:-

Table with 10 columns: Area, Section, Township, Range, Meridian, and four corner designations (SE, SW, NW, NE). Rows list land parcels of various sizes (39.50, 40.00, 39.60, 20.80 acres) and a total of 299.90 acres.

Note:- The lands described in this certificate are also irrigated with the waters of Cow Creek, permit No. 6397, subject of Certificate No. 1934. The combined right from the two sources is limited to 2.99 c.f.s. or 914 acre feet for the season.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired, and to the purpose for which acquired.
