CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, C. H. Ketcham, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Silver Queen Spring through a developed spring and distribution system for Mining purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 23, T.9N., R.39E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 23, bears N. 80° 07' 04" W., a distance of 3,902.55 feet, situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Kenneth A. Silver
Post-office address Carson City, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.210 c.f.s., but not to exceed 32,486 million gallons per annum
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 6, 1974

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed from a spring, thence conveyed 3,900 feet by a 2" pipeline where it is used for mining purposes within the NW 1/4 of Section 23, T.9N., R.39E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the Permit and also to the terms and conditions of the State Engineer's Ruling dated July 17, 1975.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
