CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Thomas J. Hall, Agent has presented to the State Engineer

of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

North Zephyr Cove Creek

through diversion box and distribution system for

Quasi-Municipal

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 3, T.13N.,

R.18E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 3 bears

N. 23° 02' E., a distance of 1,329.96 feet

situated in Douglas County, State of Nevada:

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Skyland Water Company, Inc.

Post-office address Stateline, Nevada

*Amount of appropriation 1.0 c.f.s., but not to exceed 28,059,599.2 million gallons annually

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

**Date of priority of appropriation May 9, 1968

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted from the North Zephyr Cove Creek by a diversion box, thence conveyed to a settling pond and filtering system, thence pumped into a 500,000 gallon

storage tank, thence conveyed to the place of use located within the NW 1/4, S 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 3, S 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 3, East of U.S. Highway 50, N 1/4 N 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 10,

East of U.S. Highway 50, N 1/4 N 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 10, all within T.13N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., where it serves the Skyland Subdivision, Park and Douglas County departments.

*This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total combined annual duty granted under this certificate and Permit 36036 and the Skyland Water Company, Inc., portion of Permit 36037, shall not exceed 28,059,599.2 million gallons annually.

**This certificate changes the place of use of Permit 24474, Certificate 8287, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 24474, Certificate 8287.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
