CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert W. Millard, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Mount Wilson Reservoir

through a reservoir for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 1, T. 4N., R. 66E., M. D. B. & M., or at a point from which the NW 1/4 corner of said Section 1 bears N. 35° 11' W., a distance of 4574.0 feet

situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Imperial Farms Land and Cattle Co., Inc.

Post-office address Ely, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.00668 c.f.s., or sufficient water to water 707 head of cattle

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation August 7, 1978

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is impounded in the Mount Wilson Reservoir which is from spring and flood runoff. It is on a natural channel and the reservoir is 60 feet wide 167 feet long and 5 feet deep. It supplies water for 707 head of cattle within a portion of Section 1, T. 4N., R. 66E., M. D. B. & M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
