CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert W. Millard, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Fryling Pan Spring through a spring and stockwatering facilities for stockwatering and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 1, T.4N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 1 bears N. 33° 06' 58" E., a distance of 4493.02 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Imperial Farms Land and Cattle Co., Inc.
Post-office address: Ely, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0056 c.f.s., or sufficient water to water 450 head of cattle
Period of use, from: January 1st to: December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: August 18, 1978

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
A cleaned out spring area with the water diverted into a stockwatering facility, thence the overflow flowing into a small reservoir where it waters 450 head of cattle within Section 1, T.4N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
