CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert W. Millard, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Pony Well) through a drilled well, windmill and trough for stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 35, T.6N., R.66E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Section 35 bears S. 25° 15' 30" W., a distance of 1874.25 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows: Imperial Farms Land and Cattle Co., Inc., Frank Delmue Name of appropriator and a partnership consisting of Kenneth and Gordon Lytle Post-office address Ely, Nevada Amount of appropriation 0.0044 c.f.s., or sufficient water to water 450 head of cattle Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year Date of priority of appropriation April 26, 1978

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: A drilled well, 8 inch casing with 30 foot windmill equipped with 60 feet of 1 1/2 inch galvanized pipe which runs to metal trough 90 feet long 2 feet wide and 8 inches deep. It waters 450 head of cattle within the NW 1/4 of SE 1/4 of Section 35, T.6N., R.66E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
