CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Daniel Phillip Moore, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Wildhorse Spring through a developed spring and distribution system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 27, T.21N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 22, T.21N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M., bears N: 10° 55' 08" W., a distance of 8876.75 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation: 0.01368 c.f.s., but not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per annum

Date of priority of appropriation: May 27, 1977

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:
1.0 acre in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 27, T.21N., R.22E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
