CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert W. Millard, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Steward Spring No. 1 through a developed spring and natural channel for stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 2, T.5N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 2 bears S. 55° 15' E., a distance of 2132.0 feet situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Robert Steward
Post-office address: Pioche, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.0019 c.f.s., or sufficient water to water 60 head of cattle
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: September 6, 1978

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
The spring area consists of cleaning out the spring and maintaining a channel and small ponds within the channel to water 60 head of cattle within Section 2, T.5N., R.65E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
