CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Donald E. Lewis, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Unnamed Spring through a developed spring and pond for milling and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 32, T.17N., R.36E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/2 corner of said Section 32 bears S. 21° E., a distance of 1414.55 feet situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Claude B. Lovestedt
Post-office address Carson City, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.002 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.456 million gallons annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 1, 1976

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is produced at the spring which flows into a small pond, thence 5000 gallons is pumped from the pond to a storage tank every four (4) days and used for milling purposes within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 32, T.17N., R.36E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
