CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 5, T. 22N., R. 54E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Section 5 bears S. 86° 16' 48" E., a distance of 2513.57 feet situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Eureka, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.025 c.f.s., or sufficient water to water 800 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 28, 1977

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed in the well, thence conveyed to three (3) 750 gallon stockwatering troughs where 800 head of cattle are watered within the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 5, T. 22N., R. 54E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
