CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William A. Nisbet, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Harry Polly Spring

through a developed spring and channel for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 25, T.27N., R.48E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of Section 1, T.26N., R.47E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 76 0 30' W., a distance of 32470.0 feet

situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Frank Paxton and Family

Post-office address Carlin, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0125 c.f.s., or sufficient water to water 400 head of cattle

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation January 11, 1980

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

The spring area has been cleaned out to ensure flow. A ditch has been dug to divert water from the spring area to ensure flow. The place of use is within the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 25, T.27N., R.48E., M.D.B.&M. The spring is used to water 400 head of cattle.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
