CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Eugene B. Longfield, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Truckee River (Steamboat Ditch) through a headgate, ditch on controlled works for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 31, T.19N., R.18E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 31 bears S. 62° 04' E., a distance of 3195.0 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
This certificate changes the place of use and manner of use of a portion of the waters of the Truckee River as heretofore granted under Claim 65, Truckee River Final Decree. This certificate changes the manner of use from irrigation to quasi-municipal and the place of use is within portions of the following fourties in Section 35, T.19N., R.19E., M.D.B.&M., NE 1/4 SW 1/4, NW 1/4 SE 1/4, NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SW 1/4 SE 1/4 and the SE 1/4 SE 1/4, which has a total of 135.5 acres.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.
