CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Carl V. Haas, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for commercial and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 19, T.11N., R.43E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 19 bears S. 0° 42' 40" W., a distance of 100.0 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

* Amount of appropriation 0.10 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1.533 million gallons annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation December 28, 1976

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and pumped into a pressure tank which serves rental units and home, all within a portion of the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 19, T.11N., R.43E., M.D.B.&M.

*The total combined rate of diversion under this certificate and any certificate issued under Permit 30967 is limited to 0.10 c.f.s.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and conditions of the State Engineer's Ruling No. 2218 dated July 5, 1977.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
