CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Well #4) through a drilled well, pump jack and trough for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 13, T.38N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of Section 33, T.38N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 46° 10' 26" W., a distance of 25624.26 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Dalton Livestock, a partnership
Post-office address Wells, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0094 c.f.s., or sufficient water to water 300 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 27, 1978

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well, thence pumped by a Meyers pump jack with a 7 h.p. motor, thence the water flows into a 500 gallon stockwatering trough where 500 head of cattle are watered within the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 13, T.38N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
