CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Roy E. Archer, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Irrigation and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 28, T.19S., R.53E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 28 bears N. 15 00' 00" E., a distance of 880.0 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

4.38 Acres in the E 1/2 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 28, T.19S., R.53E., M.D.B.&M.

\*This certificate changes the point of diversion of a portion of Permit 19441, Certificate 5866, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 19441, Certificate 5866.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
