CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from No Name Spring through improved spring and natural channel for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 11, T.35N., R.55E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 11 bears S. 66° 30' 00" E., a distance of 1,033.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Lamoille, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0034 c.f.s., or sufficient water to water 80 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation January 8, 1979

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Works consist of a cleaned-out spring in which the water flows into a natural channel within the S 1/2 S 1/2 of Section 12, T.35N., R.55E., M.D.B.&M., where 80 head of cattle are watered.

This certificate is issued subject to the condition that the permittee must ensure that wildlife, which have customarily used such water, will have access thereto, Chapter 736, Section 5, Stats. of Nev. 1981.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
