CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Robert Pontsler, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Irrigation and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 18, T.11N., R.34E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the W 1/4 corner of said Section 18 bears S. 89° 46' 28" W., a distance of 3,704.25 feet situated in Mineral County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 4.455 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1,097.6 acre-feet per annum
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
\* Date of priority of appropriation January 13, 1972

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:

Table with 11 columns: Acres, NE 1/4, NE 1/4, Section 18, T.11N., R.34E., M.D.B.&M. Rows list various quarter-section acreages totaling 274.4 Acres.

\*This certificate changes the point of diversion of Permit 26472, therefore, the date of priority remains the same as Permit 26472.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit and with the understanding that the total duty of water shall not exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre per annum from any and/or all surfaces.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
