CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Jeanne Foster, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

The Blue Dick Spring through a cleaned out spring for milling and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 33, T.5S., R.40E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 33 bears S. 60 degrees 16' 26" E., a distance of 885.51 feet situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator The Blue Dick Milling Company
Post-office address Granada Hills, California
Amount of appropriation 1.017 c.f.s., but not to exceed 0.657 million gallons annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation May 19, 1975

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is produced from the spring thence piped into storage tanks thence into a pond where it is pumped to the place of use within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 33, T.5S., R.40E., M.D.B.&M., and used for milling and domestic purposes.

The total combined duty of water issued under this certificate and any certificate issued under Permit 29395 and Permit 29445, Certificate 10234 shall not exceed 0.932 million gallons annually.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
