CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (Well No. 4) through a drilled well, pump and stockwater trough for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 10, T.37N., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of Section 14, T.37N., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., bears S. 34 0 20' 58" E., a distance of 4635.70 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0156 c.f.s., or sufficient water to water 500 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation December 28, 1976

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed in the well thence conveyed via 50 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipeline to a stockwatering trough, 9 feet in diameter by 2 feet deep, which waters 500 head of cattle within the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 10, T.37N., R.61E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
