CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Point Spring through developed spring and ditch for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 35, T.34N., R.63E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE corner of said Section 35 bears N. 48° 40' 48" E., a distance of 1,711.21 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Clover Valley, Wells, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0312 c.f.s., or sufficient water to water 100 head of cattle
Period of use, from April 1st to November 30th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation April 26, 1979

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is produced from a developed spring, thence flows into an open ditch in which 100 head of cattle water within the NE 1/4 of NE 1/4 of Section 35, T.34N., R.63E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
