CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Ernest E. Muller, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Unnamed Spring (Spring No. 2) through a developed spring and ditch for stockwatering and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 24, T.38N., R.23 1/2 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 24 bears N. 5 0 10' W., a distance of 1830.0 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.011 c.f.s., or sufficient water to water 350 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 20, 1979

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is produced from a developed spring which flows into an open ditch and runs into a small reservoir where 350 head of cattle are watered within the NW 1/4 of Section 24, T.38N., R.23 1/2 E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
