CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, William and Melvin Gieck, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 1, T.21S., R.53E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 1 bears S. 21° 33' 04" E., a distance of 310.0 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.05 c.f.s., but not to exceed 17.75 acre-feet per annum
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
* Date of priority of appropriation April 30, 1951

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant:
3.55 acres in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 1, T.21S., R.53E., M.D.B.&M.

*This certificate changes the point of diversion of a portion of Permit 13691, Certificate 5131, therefore the date of priority remains the same as Permit 13691, Certificate 5131.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
