CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Russel W. Button, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Log Springs through a developed spring and distribution system for milling and domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 28, T.6S., R.39E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NE Corner of said Section 28 bears N. 67° 53' 27" E., a distance of 2288.76 feet situated in Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Don B. Ott
Post-office address Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0167 c.f.s., but not to exceed 2.28 million gallons annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 14, 1974

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water from the spring area is piped 300 feet by a 3/4 inch plastic pipe, thence flows into an 80 gallon storage tank from which the water is used for domestic purposes. The overflow flows into three (3) small ponds from which the water is used for placer mining. The place of use is within the E 1/2 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 28, T.6S., R.39E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
