CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. V. Caselli, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Twin Springs Dam through a ditch and pond for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 3, T.3N., R.52E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 3 bears S. 40° 56' E., a distance of 4202.69 feet situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Tonopah, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0329 c.f.s., or sufficient water to water 1000 head of cattle and 50 head of horses
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation February 20, 1975

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is from a surface source known as Twin Springs Dam. Water is conveyed by a 23,738 foot Vee ditch into a 50 feet by 50 feet by 5 feet deep pond where 1000 head of cattle and 50 head of horses are watered within the NW 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 4, T.3N., R.53E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
