CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Richard W. Forman Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and stockwatering troughs for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 24, T.33N., R.57E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SE corner of said Section 24 bears S. 86° 21' E., a distance of 486.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Lamoille, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.01 c.f.s., or sufficient water to water 250 head of cattle and 20 head of horses
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 3, 1977

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed in the well, thence conveyed by a 1 1/2 inch pipeline through an 80 gallon pressure tank into two (2) 500 gallon stockwatering troughs, all within a portion of the N 1/2 of the NE 1/4 of Section 25 and portions of the SE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 24, all in T.33N., R.57E., M.D.B.&M., where it waters 250 head of cattle and 20 head of horses.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
