CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Albert E. Smith, Permittee has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 20, T.36N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the E 1/2 corner of said Section 20 bears N. 72° 06' E., a distance of 4619.0 feet situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0000625 c.f.s., or sufficient water to water 10 head of sheep
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation August 29, 1980

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed in the well, thence conveyed by a 1 1/2 inch pipe 6 feet long to a watering trough, 3 feet by 6 feet long, where 10 head of sheep are watered within a portion of the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 20, T.36N., R.38E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
