CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John E. Curran, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for quasi-municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 15, T.24N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 15 bears S. 54° 55' W., a distance of 1072.0 feet situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Joe Capurro, Herbert Capurro and George Capurro
Post-office address Sparks, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.23 c.f.s., but not to exceed 2.957 million gallons annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 30, 1974

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed in the well, thence conveyed to a storage tank, thence via a distribution system where the water serves a trailer court for quasi-municipal purposes within a portion of the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 15, T.24N., R.21E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
