CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 7, T.34N., R.55E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the NW corner of said Section 7 bears N. 29 00' 00" W., a distance of 3243.0 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Charles H. and Lois Ann Chester

Post-office address Elko, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0031 c.f.s., or sufficient water to water 92 head of cattle

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation October 19, 1977

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed in the well, thence by a distribution system to a 36 inch in diameter stockwatering trough where 92 head of cattle are watered within a portion of the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 and the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 7, T.34N., R.55E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
