CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alan S. Boyack, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an Underground Source through a drilled well, pump and distribution system for Stockwater purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 Section 22, T.35N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the SW corner of said Section 22 bears S. 1° 11' 30" W., a distance of 520.45 feet situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0312 c.f.s., or sufficient water to water 1000 head of cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation May 10, 1977

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed in the well thence conveyed by 1-1/4 inch pipeline 5,750 feet to five (5) stockwatering troughs within the W 1/2 of the W 1/2; the NE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 22 and the S 1/2 of the SW 1/4 of Section 15, all in T.35N., R.62E., M.D.B.&M., where 1000 head of cattle water.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
