CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Herman Kishner, Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Underground (Las Vegas Artesian Basin) through a well, pump and distribution system for Quasi-Municipal purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 9, T.21S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point from which the S 1/4 corner of said Section 9 bears S. 85° 23' 17" W., a distance of 1,101.5 feet situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.20 c.f.s., but not to exceed 12.37 acre-feet annually
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 29, 1954

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is developed by means of a drilled well and pumped through a distribution system to 72 apartments and surrounding landscaping for quasi-municipal purposes within the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Section 9, T.21S., R.61E., M.D.B.&M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
